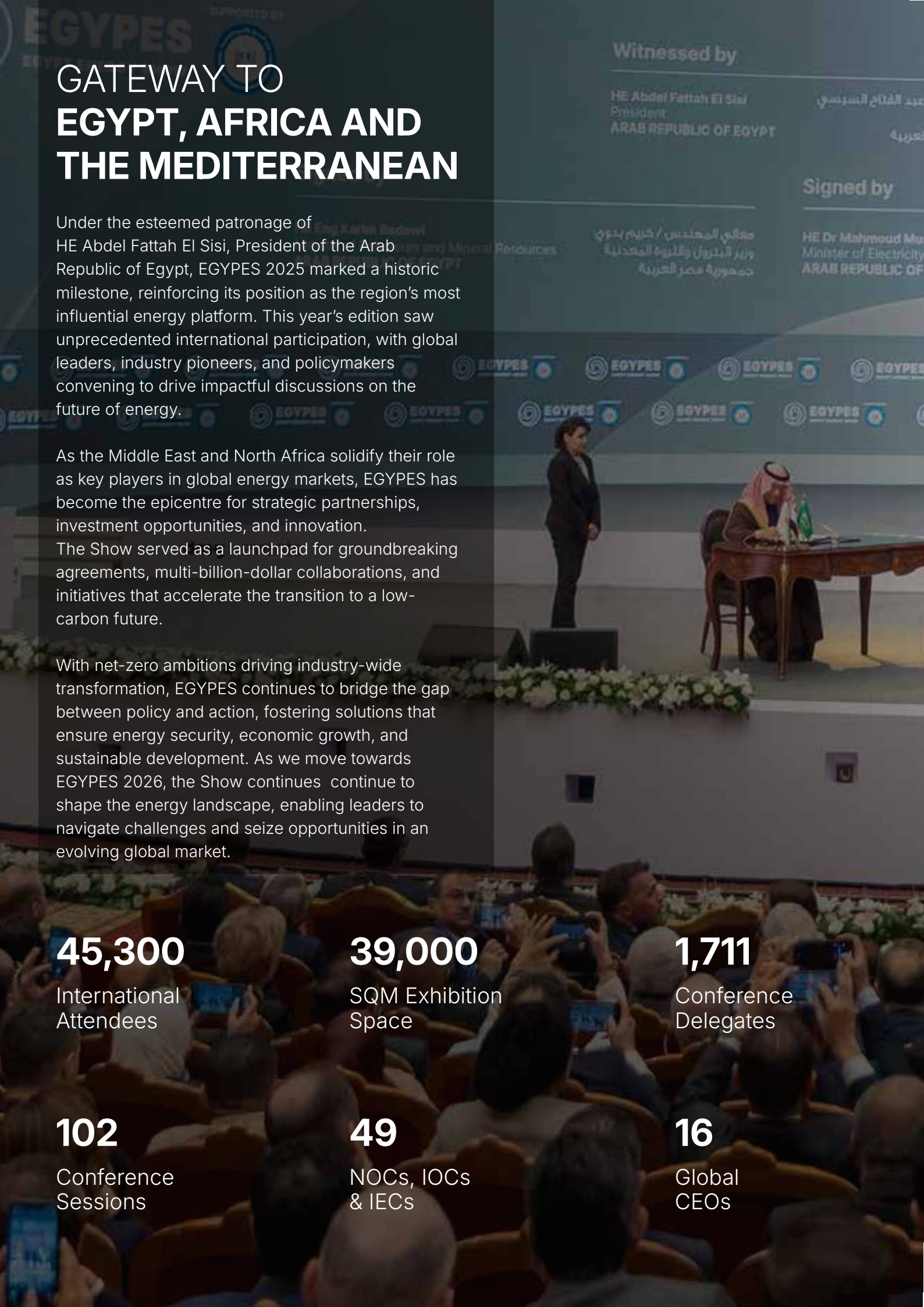

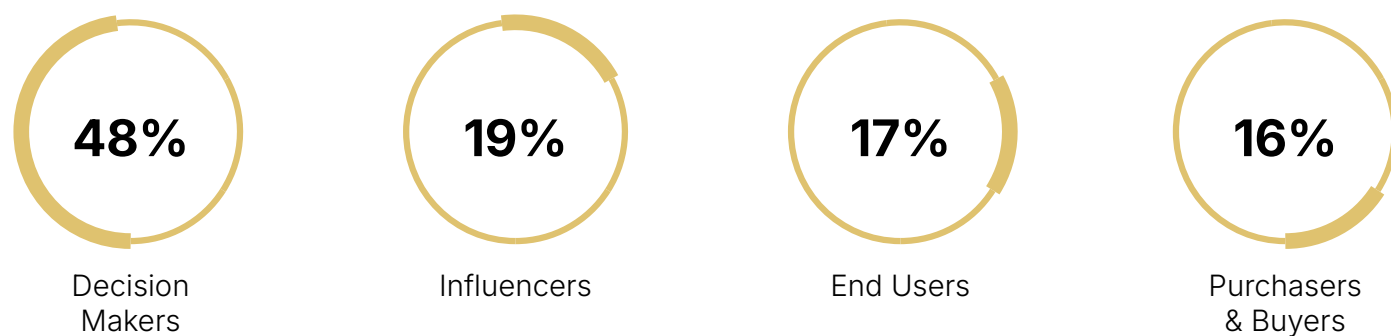

ATTENDEES BY SENIORITY

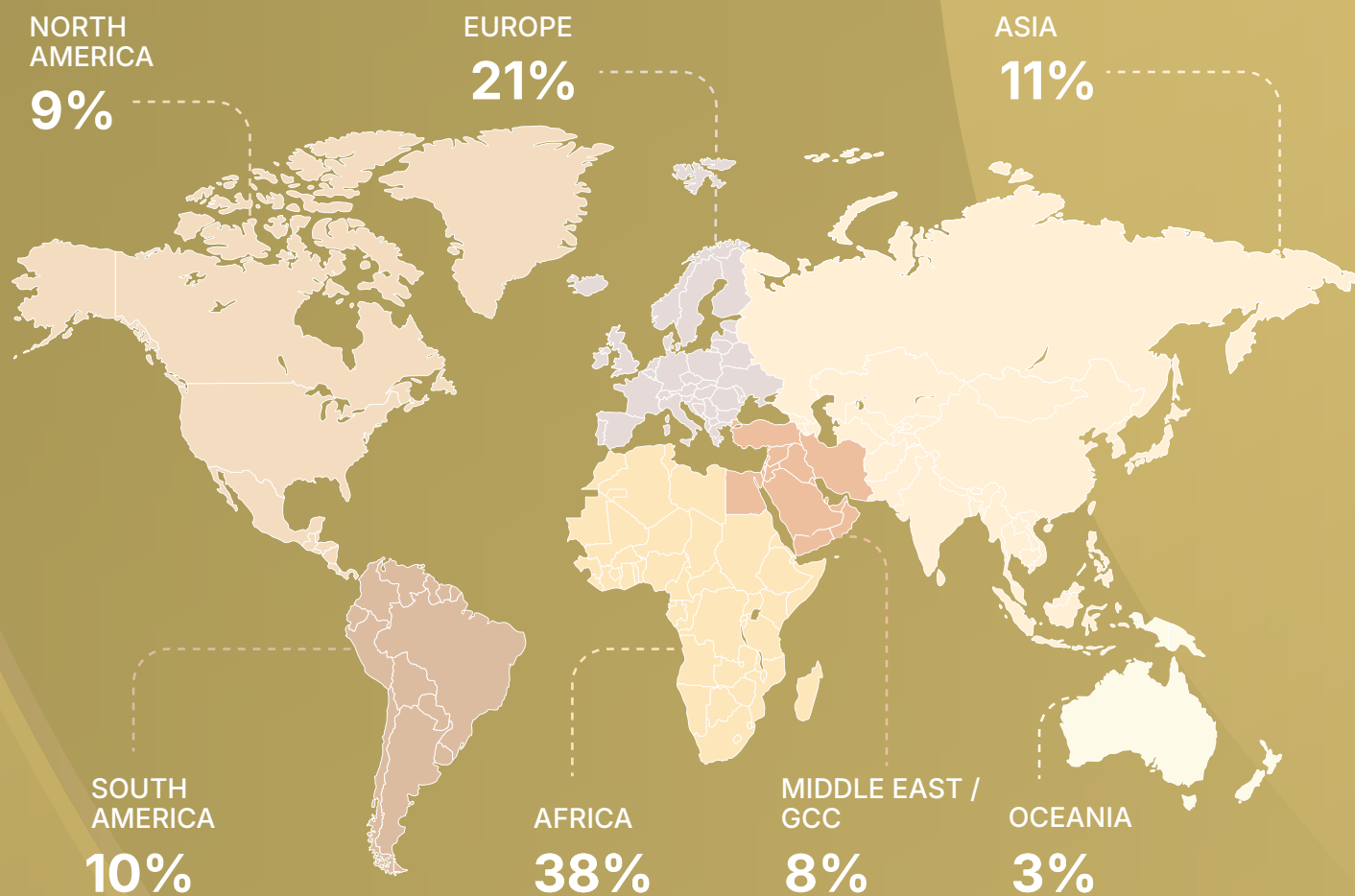
